Marvin Oliver (Quinault/Isleta-Pueblo) is one of the Northwest Coast's foremost contemporary sculptors and printmakers, who has made strides in the art world for the development and recognition of Native American Contemporary Fine Art.

Oliver's career spans over 40 years, and he has worked in a variety of media including cedar, bronze, steel and glass. The latest period of his work has been characterized by mixed-media pieces such as his blown glass 'Salish Basket' and 'Spirit Board' series with etched photographs and bronze ravens.

Oliver has also become renowned for the grand size of his

sculptures such as the 26 ft. long suspended steel and glass piece 'Mystical Journey' at the Seattle Children's hospital. His monumental public works have been installed throughout the state of Washington and the United States, Canada, Japan and Italy.

Marvin Oliver is Professor Emeritus of American Indian Studies at the University of Washington. ♣
